Key Entry Alarm – HS4313Congratulations on a wise purchase!

TOOLS NEEDED:Small Phillips head screwdriverSmall flat head screwdriver

INSTALLATION
Alarm should be mounted on door and magnet on door frame, or vice versa using the adhesive strips or screws provided. They should be located approximately 24 to 36 inches above the door knob, next to the edge of the door. Remove battery compartment then follow these guidelines for simple and cover installation:

- Screw Mounting
 a) Determine the best position for alarm. Insert and tighten one screw until it is approximately 1/8 inch from the mounting surface.
 - b) Hang alarm on mounting screws and pull it downwards until the screws are positioned in the small end of the keyholes.
 - Remove the bottom cover of the magnet using a flat head screwdriver, mount the bottom cover with two screws, snap in the magnet top enclosure on the bottom cover, the arrow c) Remove

on the magnet top enclosure on the bottom cover, the arrow on the magnet should point to the center line of the alarm.

2. Adhesive Tape Mounting
Clean and dry the surface on the door and door frame thoroughly at the location where the alarm is to be installed.

a) Peel off one side of the protective cover on the adhesive strips provided and attach them to the back of the alarm and the magnet

- strips provided and attach them to the back of the attach the magnet.
 b) Peel off the other protective cover and press alarm firmly against the door or door frame in the location chosen.
 c) Peel off the other protective cover and press the magnet firmly against the door frame or door with arrow pointing to the center line of the alarm.

 3. Battery Connection
 Install two AAA batteries. Replace the compartment cover and fasten it with screw.

4. The alarm is in operation.

Note: The distance between the alarm and the magnet should be as close as possible and it should not exceed 1/4 inch.

INSTRUCTIONS

The alarm is designed with a two position mode switch, i.e., Instant alarm and Delayed alarm.

Instant alarm: With the mode switch in this position and the key switch in the "ON" position, the alarm sounds instantly when the door is opened and will continue for 90 seconds. This mode is used when the homeowner is inside the house.

Delayed alarm: When the homeowner is away, the key switch should be put to the "ON" position and operation to Delayed alarm. There will be approximately 12-18 seconds delay time to exit and close the door. The green indicator lights up during this period. After the 12-18 seconds delay, the alarm arms automatically. When the homeowner returns from outside, he has approximately 12 seconds to open the door and turn off the key switch. No alarm will occur. The red indicator lights up during

this period. However, if the unit is not turned off by the end of the delay, the alarm automatically sounds and will continue for 90 seconds or until the key switch is turned off.

Note: To disable the alarm sooner than 90 seconds, set the key switch in the "OFF" position.

Intrusion indicator: The LED flashes green light to indicate intrusion was detected. Set the key switch in the "OFF" posit to turn off the indicator. position

Low battery indicator: In either ON/OFF mode of the key switch, the LED flashes red light to indicate the installed batteries need to be replaced.
